



Fénelon Private School

Created by the sisters of Saint Joseph, a congregation founded by Father Médaille, and named in honour of François de Salignac de la Mothe-Fénelon (1651-1715), the school opened its doors in 1908.

Formerly a girls' school, now **co-educational**, the school is under contract with the State, it respects the same obligations as public schools in terms of teaching (timetables, curricula, examinations). With more than **1500 pupils and students** and **150 teaching and support staff**,



Fénelon welcomes children from the very youngest section to Higher Education, and offers them a **quality schooling**.

Our school complex extends on **3 sites**: a nursery and primary school, a secondary school and post-baccalaureate classes. 2 sports facilities complete the infrastructure. All our premises have disabled access.

Our educational project in 7 items

- Welcoming ► Paying attention to each person's reality
- Knowing ► Valuing all successes
- Recognise
 Allow each person to live in mutual respect

Accompany ► Give each person the tools to achieve and fulfil themselves

- Empower ► To be at the heart of reality, to live in a place with respected rules

- Communicate ► Promote communication, to exercise a critical and informed eye






Cultural openness

The organisation of **conferences**, **exhibitions**, cultural **outings** (theatre, cinema, short film festival, etc.), trips, partnerships with Germany, the USA and Spain, **trips** to Italy, Greece or Ireland, enable students to **open up to the world** and discover different cultures.

ERASMUS + in our Secondary School: A **European partnership project** on the theme of mobility aims at raising students' awareness, aged 12 to 19, to the issues of mobility in the



21st century, whether virtual or real, to sharpen their critical thinking skills to act as **European citizens**. It is a school exchange partnership that started in 2019 between schools in six European countries: France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Portugal and Spain.
