## MEDIA and FUTURE OF EUROPE





The beginning of our presentation was an introduction of our group and a description of our trip to Switzerland. Firstly, we explained


the meaning of a word "media". We asked everyone what was media for them and which position did it have in our community.

The first exercise was distribution of values of news nowadays. This exercise could help us see in which condition is the knowledge of our classmates and friends.


